What's in it for me?

The Facilitator Development Programme (FDP) is our flagship approach to recruiting and developing outstanding facilitators for teacher and technician-led CPD across STEM Learning. It presents an exciting opportunity to develop the skills you need to make a real difference to your fellow educators and young people they engage with.

There are three stages of training, each stage linked to a particular aspect of facilitating professional development and support. On completion of the training at each stage, you will be awarded our prestigious CPD Quality Mark, demonstrating that you meet the very highest standards required to deliver our programmes.

Stage 1, which leads to Associate CPD Quality Mark, focusses on the skills required to deliver effective professional development.

Stage 2, resulting in Lead CPD Quality Mark, looks at how to plan intervention support packages using tools and data, to improve departmental outcomes through teacher development.

Stage 3, for experienced facilitators, leads to Senior CPD Quality Mark. It supports more intensive school interventions, for example working with groups of schools across a multi-academy trust or working with senior leaders and governors across STEM within a single school or college.

In addition, we provide on-going support for our facilitators through our suite of bolt-on courses. These support specific needs, for example, how to best facilitate remote learning.
